

Camping Information for Bike MS: Waves to Wine Saturday, September 24th, 2016

- Camping will be provided at no cost for riders on Saturday, September 24th at the Camping area in Sonoma Mountain Village.
- Limited spaces are available. Please reserve a camping spot by logging into your participant center. On the "Home" tab, click on the "Confirm Your Camping" button and fill in your information. NOTE: Please check with your team captain before you make a reservation. Some team captains have already made group reservations with spots for all team members camping. In order to avoid duplicate camping spot reservations, please check with your captain first. Camping reservations are due by Thursday, **September 15**th, **2016**.
- The site is comprised of two large baseball fields. Camping spots will be organized in a grid-like pattern of 10' X 10' squares.
- The camping field is comprised of uneven terrain, and we encourage cyclists to bring sleeping pads.
- Please bring your own tent, sleeping bags, sleeping pads, and any other overnight supplies you will need for your camping accommodations. If you need to rent a tent, Sports Basement provides tent rentals. For more information, please visit their website here.
- Shower trucks and portable toilets will be available at the site. The hours of operation for the shower trucks are from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Overnight Pet Policy: Dogs are not allowed to stay overnight in our Rider Camping Village.
- RV and Trailers Policy: If you would like an RV camping spot, please email nick.macfalls@nmss.org. You will then be sent an RV camping agreement form. In order to reserve a spot for Bike MS: Waves to Wine, you must send the completed and signed form to nick.macfalls@nmss.org by September 1st, 2016. Please submit one reservation per vehicle. Registered participants can only complete one reservation. Reservations are limited to the first 20 applicants. Once you receive a confirmation, only then do you have a reserved spot.
- NOTE: There is no electricity overnight at the campground to plug in chargers or any other electrical appliances.
